Start and finish

The walk will start and finish at Five Rivers Leisure Centre. You will find your registration time on the front of this walker pack.

At the finish you will be greeted by a member of staff who will register you as 'completed'. You will then receive your medal and Forget Me Not seeds to sow at home as a living memory. You are invited to enjoy a hot drink and a bacon roll at the Wood Bar café, located in the centre. Please make sure you check back in so we know you are safely off the course.

Parking and transport

There is a car park at the leisure centre but spaces are limited, so please car share and arrange other transport where possible. Unfortunately due to health and safety, staff members will not be able to provide transport on the night so please ensure this is arranged beforehand.

Dogs

Well behaved dogs, on leads are welcome to take part. Please ensure you pick up after your dog on route..

First aiders will be located at the leisure centre. If you should need assistance, please inform a marshal or call the emergency contact number located at the end of the route instructions.

Withdrawal

If you need to withdraw before finishing the route, please immediately advise a marshal or call the emergency contact number which you will find at the end of the route instructions.

The safety of all our walkers is paramount and we need to be able to account for each and every one of you.



Clothing

Please wear suitable clothing for the walk and bring a waterproof. Wear sensible shoes, such as trainers or walking boots. Please wear your Midnight Walk t-shirt and as much neon as you can muster!

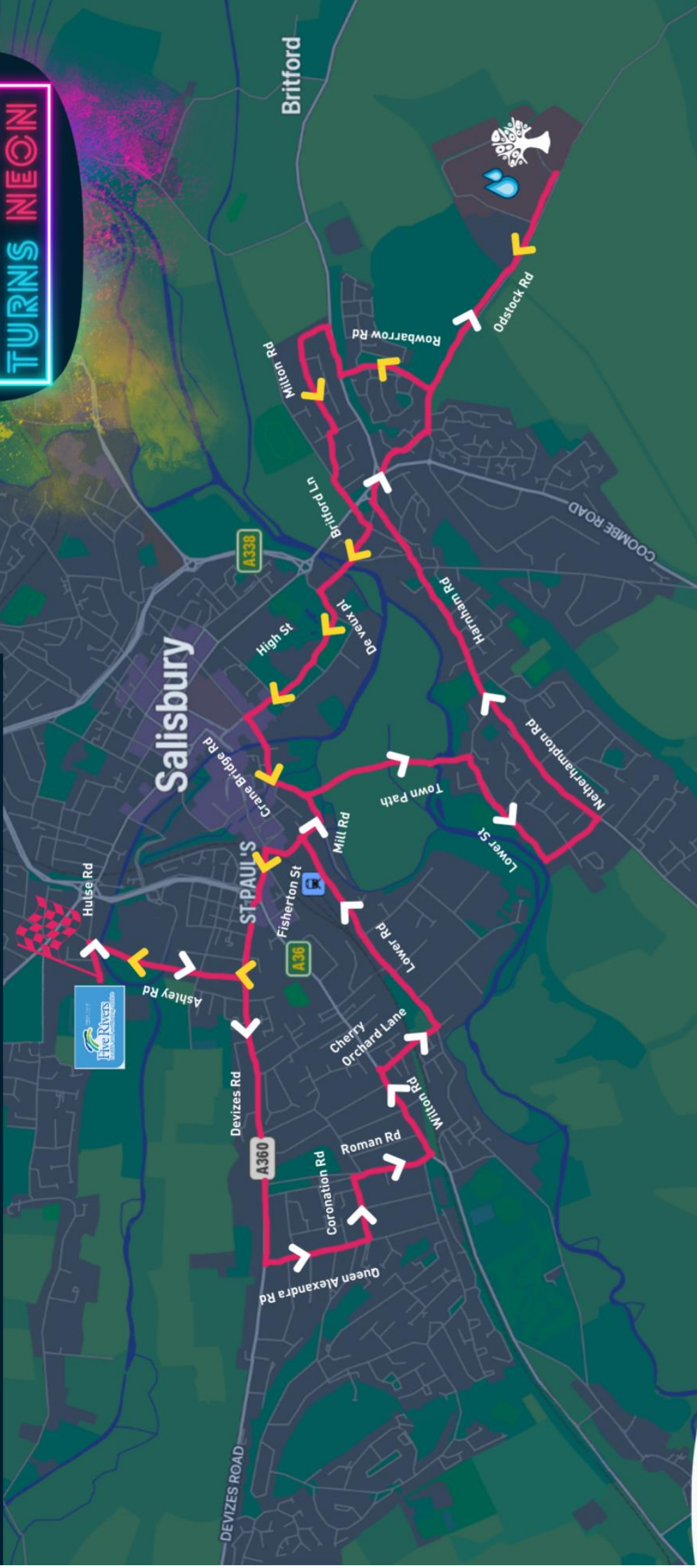

The route

Leave Five Rivers and turn right into Ashley Road

Turn right into Devizes Road

Turn left into Queen Alexandra Road **CROSS AT LIGHTS**

Turn left into Coronation Road

Turn right into Roman Road

Turn left into Wilton Road

Turn right into Cherry Orchard Lane

Turn left into Lower Road/Churchfields Road

Turn right into Mill Road

Turn right onto Town Path **WARNING! DEEP WATER, KEEP RIGHT**

***Follow Town Path until the end**

Turn right into Middle Street (route splits)

Follow road left into Upper Street

Turn left into Netherhampton Road

Continue along Netherhampton Road which becomes Harnham Road

CROSSING AT LIGHTS

At main Harnham Road roundabout **CROSS AT PEDESTRIAN LIGHTS**

Take the footpath towards Ambulance station until joining Odstock Road

Follow Odstock Road to Salisbury District Hospital, enter at Entrance B and proceed to Hospice

Leave Hospice and turn right into Odstock Road down hill

Turn right into Rowbarrow

Turn right into Downton Road **CROSSING AT LIGHTS** then left into Milton Road

Follow Milton Road to the end then turn right into Burford Road and immediately left into Burford Avenue

Follow road to end and turn left into Britford Lane

Cross Newbridge Road into Britford Lane West

Turn right into Aylesward Road and continue onto St Nicholas Road

Turn left into De Vaux Place

Enter Cathedral Close

Leave Cathedral Close following signs to exit at High Street

Turn left into Crane Street

The route

Cross mini roundabout into Mill Road and continue along Mill Road over mini roundabouts
Turn right into Southwestern Road
Turn left into Fisherton Street under the railway bridge
Cross St Pauls roundabout using **CROSSING ON WILTON ROAD**
Continue up Devizes Road
Turn right into Ashley Road
Turn left into Hulse Road
FINISH at Leisure Centre
