Leading up to the event, the creative group sessions involved exploring ideas, on the type of delicious food to enjoy, activities and music at the Summer Garden Party. Each patient chose a popular garden party game including guess the weight of the cake; how many sweets in a jar and a raffle. The morning was full of laughter and thoroughly enjoyed by all. A special lunch, was prepared including all of the delicious choices the patients had asked for when planning the Summer Garden Party. Including egg with cress, smoked salmon sandwiches, scrumptious sausage rolls and delightful mini scones. No Summer Garden Party could be without some Spanish music, played by Andrew Spence during the lunchtime buffet.





Treatment Room

Last year we embarked on a rather large project at the Hospice to redesign a dedicated space which revolves around the safe management of medication for patients. A project known as the Treatment Room. An environment that supports the delivery of high quality care for patients who attend the Hospice for symptom management.

The Treatment Room at the Hospice enables patients to receive medication in one location, opposed to a hospital admission. The Treatment Room increases the speed at which we can safely manage symptoms, resulting in patients having reported reduced pain quickly.

The room, was both outdated and lacking in workable space for staff to cater for more than one patient at a time. With input from Clinical and Pharmaceutical staff, the remodel is now complete. The new Treatment Room is fitted with bespoke medical storage, new lighting and plenty of work top space for preparation of treatments to increase the capacity of up to three staff members at any one time, who can prepare medications safely and efficiently.





This increased efficiency of the Treatment Room means that patients receiving palliative and end of life care can focus on spending their days in greatly reduced pain, surrounded by loved ones and creating lasting memories. This is effective for patients both in the inpatient unit and at home.

This wonderful new facility is funded by Salisbury Hospice Charity.





There were inspirational words from Nikki Spicer and a moment of reflection from Revd. Kelvin Inglis, before a high energy warm up from Alex Taylor of Girls Love Fit.
